INFORMATION ON APPLICATION FOR OPPORTUNITY FUND (Updated as of 6 Dec 2019)

Introduction

The MOE Opportunity Fund (OF) scheme levels up the co-curricular development opportunities for **Singapore Citizen students** from lower income households. The scheme focuses on creating opportunities which they would otherwise miss out on due to family circumstances.

Guidelines

- 2. Priority for subsidy will be given to students who would otherwise be denied the opportunity for enrichment programmes/overseas trips due to financial hardship.
- 3. Students / Parents will co-pay at least 20% to reinforce parental responsibility for and commitment to their children's participation in overseas trips and/or enrichment activities.

Eligibility

- 4. <u>Category A</u> students are those eligible for MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) or the School Advisory Committee (SAC) Bursary. **These students are eligible to apply for the OF for areas (a) to (e) in the table below.**
- 5. <u>Category B</u> students **are eligible to apply for the OF for area (e) in the table below** based on their household Per-Capita Income as follows:-

Below \$900	80%
\$901 to \$1000	70%
\$1001 to \$1300	50%
\$1301 to \$1600	30%
\$1601 to \$1800	20%
